

**The project «Europe Knowledge Analysis » was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"**

**Participation:**

The project involved Participation: The project involved 481 citizens. notably 57 participants from Kista(Sweden) ,196 participants from the city of La Hoya – Elche (Spain), 57 participants from the city of Montegranaro. (Italy),57 participants from the city of Thessaloniki (Greece),57 participants from Kranenburg (Germany), and 57 participants from the city of Burgh-Hamstead (The Netherlands). We had 6 partner countries. (Sweden, Italy, Germany, Netherlands, Greece, and Spain) involved in the project which were chosen based on their experience in promoting the civil and democratic participation of their citizens.

**Location/ Dates:**

**The Kick-off event** took place Online (Kista, Sweden), from 01/03/2021 to 01/03/2021. Short description: The day of 01/03/2021 was dedicated to the project coordinators from all participating organizations and citizens to be part of the project it was meant to explain to them the project so that they can understand the project, its aims, and its objectives; to clarify the work plan and the main phases of the project.

**The first International Workshop** took place in Thessaloniki (Greece) from 29/03/2022 to 30/03/2022. The day of 29/03/2022 was dedicated to analyzing the different shades of Euroscepticism, the reasons and nature of EU rejection, tools to debunk Euroscepticism, and exchanging best practices. The day of 30/03/2022 was dedicated to Experts and professors who developed the subject and guided the participants to share experiences from their own country, analyze the differences, and realize that Euroscepticism is not something to be afraid of. It is part of a vibrant European democracy.

**The second International Workshop** took place in Burgh Hamstead (The Netherlands) from 22/02/2022 to 24/04/2022. Short description: The day of 23/04/2022 was dedicated to analyzing the Migration phenomenon. The themes covered in the Workshop were: 1. Migration in history 2. Data and facts about the migrant crisis, 3. EU policies on asylum, 4. Tools to debunk xenophobia, 4. Exchange of best practices.

**The third international workshop** took place in La Hoya – Elche (Spain) from 23/03/2022 to 21/05/2022. Short description: The day of 21/05/2022 was dedicated to analyzing the phenomenon of Propaganda. The themes covered in the Workshop were: 1. analysis of propaganda mechanisms, 2. media literacy exercise.

**The fourth international workshop** occurred in Montegranaro (Italy) from 06/07/2022 to 12/09/2022. Short description: The day of 06/07/2022 was dedicated to analyzing and debating the subject of a united Europe- for the Counter narratives of Europe. Are EU countries united? What are the differences faced in different countries regarding the same issue? Experts participating in the seminar showed and made sure that the participants understood the counternarratives of Europe.

**The Final project's International Workshop** took place in Kranenburg (Germany) from 10/02/2023 to 15/02/2023. Short description: The days were dedicated to making a global evaluation of the project results and main outputs. Moreover, it brought together leading practitioners and experts to discuss and exchange ideas regarding gathering recommendations and wishes from citizens of Europe - for EU2030.
